You will discover new perspectives to empower changes in your community, strengthening your competencies, gain intercultural experiences and have a lot of fun.

The programme consists of innovative **workshops**, stimulating **debates**, interactive **performances**, **simulations** and **outdoor activities** around four key topics:

Power and the role of civil society

Digital tools for doing good

There is no planet B

Inequality and discrimination? Not with us!

The workshops will be offered by experts on these topics, so you can **get informed, take a stand and act** on these issues.

Our aim is to bring together a diverse group of young people in the Hanseatic city of Lübeck – a symbolic haven towards Europe – ready to exchange ideas, inspire each other and act on issues that matter to you! By creating a platform for young people from all over Europe, we want to work together on these issues and create an atmosphere of change.

We are convinced: you(th) can make change happen!

Who is organising the event?

SAME – Solidarity Action Day Movement in Europe – is a European umbrella organisation that brings together several youth organisations carrying out an annual **Solidarity Action Day**. On this day, pupils get the chance to exercise a job of their choice instead of going to school. They donate their salaries to youth-related projects from all over the world. The message of the Solidarity Action Day is simple: you(th) can make change happen!

In all of SAME member organisations youth is in charge: They lead the organisation as board

members, elect projects that are supported or organise the annual Solidarity Action Day campaign. SAME believes in the power of young people and encourages them to become a driver of societal change in their local and the global community.

SHL - Schüler Helfen Leben – is the biggest relief organization led by young people in Germany and one of the founding members of SAME. SHL supports youth and education projects in Southeastern Europe, Jordan and Germany in the areas of anti-discrimination, youth activism and support for refugees.

Once a year, Schüler Helfen Leben organizes the Solidarity Action Day in Germany. Besides that, SHL informs at schools about the situation in Southeast Europe, Syria and Jordan and motivate young people to make an effort for relevant social topics like education, integration and equal opportunities.
